**FORE!!!!!!** - Community Church Golf Outing, June 26 at Westridge Golf Course. More information to come!

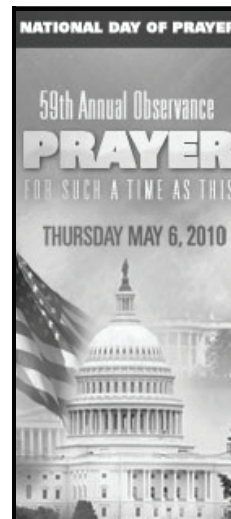
**Save the Date!** The Annual Community Church Picnic will be Sunday, August 29. More information to come.
